A scholarship will be awarded for Aquatic Center fees to one member of each of the four squads according to established need, commitment to the sport and responsibility to the program.

All applications must be submitted with supporting financial documentation. A complete financial aid application consists of the most recently-filed tax returns, 1099's or W2's (with social security numbers redacted) and a statement explaining the circumstances of the financial hardship and a written statement from the athlete of why rowing is important to them. If a grant is awarded there will be a 10 hour community service commitment to the boathouse, supervised by a rowing coach.
